SUN 08 Delegates depart for New York. With the time difference, you arrive into New York on the same day.

POST CONFERENCE TOUR

NOVA SCOTIA & PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND 14-21 MAY 2011

SAT 14 HALIFAX – Upon arrival in Halifax, the group will be taken on a city highlights tour. Dinner is included at a local tavern after an included tour of an historic brewery.

SUN 15 HALIFAX REGION TOURING – Travel along the scenic Marine Drive to the picturesque village of Peggy's Cove, then the UNESCO World Heritage listed site of Lunenburg and finally to the village of Mahone Bay, named one of Canada's most beautiful towns.

MON 16 HALIFAX – CHARLOTTETOWN – You'll travel into New Brunswick this morning to see Hopewell Rocks and then cross the world's longest continual multi-span bridge to Charlottetown on Prince Edward Island.

TUE 17 PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND TOURING – The day starts with a walking tour of Charlottetown, followed by touring in the countryside. There will be a visit to the Green Gables House, famous from the Anne of Green Gables novels & some coast driving to Cabot Beach Park. Tonight enjoy a lobster dinner in true Maritimes style.

WED 18 CHARLOTTETOWN – BADDECK – We take the ferry this morning back to Nova Scotia via Pictou, the birthplace of New Scotland and onto Cape Breton Island for a visit to the Alexander Graham Bell Museum and onto your hotel, overlooking Bras d'Or Lake.

THU 19 CAPE BRETON ISLAND TOURING – You'll travel along the famous Cabot Trail today past lochs, glens, sea-swept headlands and steep cliffs in Cape Breton Highlands National Park, with a visit to the cultural centre at Les Trois Pignons. There will be a picnic lunch, before enjoying the vista over the Atlantic Ocean & Cape Smokey.

FRI 20 BADDECK – HALIFAX – This morning you'll get a glimpse of the military history of this region with a visit to the Fortress of Louisbourg. After lunch, we head back to Halifax for some free time before a farewell dinner at the hotel.

SAT 21 HALIFAX – The tour ends this morning with a transfer to the airport, leaving the Atlantic Maritimes behind.
